Bids are hereby invited in terms of Section 83 of the Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000 (as amended) and Sections 110 and 112 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, Act 56 of 2003, for a panel of service providers to enter into the lease of a newly constructed Fresh Produce Market Distribution Centre for the period of five years.

BID SUBMISSION

Sealed bids with the bid number and description of the bid endorsed on the envelope: with the bidders details clearly indicated, must be deposited in the Bid Box in the foyer of the Okhahlamba Local Municipality's bid box situated in the reception at or before **11:00 on Monday 20 July 2016**, at which time bids will be opened in public in the municipal's Boardroom. Bids received after the said closing date and time and not clearly marked as prescribed will not be considered. Facsimile and e-mailed bids will not be accepted.

The Okhahlamba Local Municipality subscribes to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act no 5 of 2000 and Preferential Procurement Regulations 2011. The 90/10 preference points will be applicable and bids may only be submitted on the bid documentation that is issued. Bidders need to first score a minimum of 60% in terms of the Pre-Qualification in order for the bid to be considered. An original valid Tax Clearance Certificate, certified copy of B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates and other required documents must accompany the bid document.
